Mayo Cardiovascular Review Course for Cardiology Boards and Recertification

August 26-30, 2017 • Mayo Civic Center • Rochester, Minnesota

We are inviting you to participate in a scholarship program to enhance the preparation for the Cardiovascular Boards of the trainees in your cardiovascular training program. As Program Directors, we all understand the daunting effort that is required in order to assure that our cardiovascular trainees become knowledgeable in all aspects of cardiovascular diseases, a requirement to pass the American Board of Internal Medicine Subspecialty Board on Cardiovascular Diseases. Due to the increasing knowledge base of cardiovascular disease, it is increasingly more difficult to assure an adequate broad knowledge base for our fellows.

We, and others, have found that fellows are able to obtain a comprehensive view of a broad range of subjects by frequent interaction and discussion with their peers. One successful tactic has been to identify a second or third year fellow to be responsible for running frequent "board review" sessions with their peers, attempting to cover all aspects of cardiovascular diseases.

We would like to support this concept by offering a scholarship to exceptional fellows to attend our Mayo Cardiovascular Board Review Course, August 26-30, 2017 in Rochester, Minnesota. This course is a five-day course, with online content as well, which covers all areas of cardiovascular diseases through both didactic teaching as well as interactive board simulation question/answer sessions. Outstanding second and third-year fellows from fellowship programs are selected as scholarship recipients. Scholarship recipients receive free tuition to the 2017 Board Review Course as well as a DVD set of last year's lectures. It is envisioned that this fellow takes this information back to hold teaching and discussion sessions with his/her peers. The scholarship program has been met with great support from fellowship program directors across the nation. Awardees appreciated the opportunity for learning, the financial support, and the ability to interface with key speakers in our course. The success of the scholarship program has truly proven to be a unique and collegial opportunity for our up-and-coming colleagues.
