Included in the letter of recommendation should be information regarding current level of training and confirmation of plans to remain in an accredited cardiology fellowship program in 2017. The selection process will be based upon the qualities of:

- ❖ Knowledge of cardiovascular diseases and interventional cardiology
- ❖ Interest in education
- ❖ Evidence of academic leadership

The deadline for receipt of scholarship packet is **June 1, 2017**.
